Steps to Identify and break lies

Pray through each of these lies one by one. As you do this, a memory may come to your mind or you might sense there may be more the Lord wants to do, take time and let Him speak to you. You can ask yourself "When have I felt this way before. Lord, show me where this started." Allow the Lord to speak truth to you in that situation. If you were hurt by someone, bless them and repent of any bit-terness you allowed in. Take responsibility for your part while recognizing that you have an enemy (father of lies) who helped bring the wound in the first place. This may not be necessary on every lie, so allow God to lead you.

One by one, ask:

"Lord Jesus forgive me for making this agreement with the enemy and believing the lie that
Jesus deliver me from my enemy. I am Your child. I will not allow this lie to determine my life. In
the Name and through Your blood Jesus, I break this lie and the agreement I made. Jesus take back
the ground that I gave to the enemy. I give that ground to You. Lord replace this lie with the truth of
who You say I am. Thank you Father for reviling this lie to me and breaking it's hold over my life."

Now you must begin to replace the lies with truth! Search scripture for the truth of who God says you are and write it down. Read it daily until you began to believe it and live it!

<u>Practical Steps Once You Identify a Lie</u>

- 1. Share a lie you have been believing.
- 2. Identify and share the earliest memory.
- 3. Acknowledge the true pain or hurt.
- 4. Find your PR Personal Responsibility.
- 5. Forgive, bless, and pray for those who hurt you.
- 6. Speak what is true and begin to replace the lie with the truth.


